SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This appliance should not be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote control system, other than that supplied with this appliance.

This appliance is intended for domestic use only. It should not be used for commercial purposes.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

STEP 1: Switch off and unplug the hand mixer from the mains power supply before performing any cleaning or user maintenance.

STEP 2: Wipe the hand mixer motor unit with a soft, damp cloth and allow to dry thoroughly.

STÉP 3: Wash all of the attachments in warm, soapy water, then rinse and dry thoroughly.

Do not immerse the hand mixer motor unit in water or any other liquid.

The hand mixer is not suitable for use in a dishwasher.

NOTE: Always clean the hand mixer immediately after each use.

Instructions for Use

Before First Use

Clean the hand mixer and its attachments following the instructions in the section entitled 'Care and Maintenance'.

NOTE: When using the mixer for the first time, a slight odour may be emitted. This is normal and will soon subside. Allow for sufficient ventilation around the hand mixer.

Using the Hand Mixer

All attachments must be securely fitted before use; do not attempt to remove them until the attachment has stopped moving.

STEP 1: Before connecting the hand mixer to the mains power supply, carefully attach the desired attachment onto the hand mixer by aligning the tabs and pushing in until they click into place.

STEP 2: Place the food to be prepared into a mixing jug or bowl, then plug in and switch on the hand mixer at the mains power supply.

STEP 3: With the attachment secure, lower into the mixing jug and then move the 5-speed selector switch to the desired speed setting.

STEP 4: Slowly move the hand mixer in a clockwise direction to avoid splashing. Once mixing is complete, move the 5-speed selector switch back to '0' to switch off the hand mixer.

STEP 5: After use, switch off and unplug the hand mixer from the mains power supply. Remove the attachments by gently pulling them outwards whilst holding down the eject button. Do not press the eject button without holding the attachments, as they may drop.

NOTE: Whilst mixing liquid, especially hot liquid, use a tall container or whisk small quantities at a time to reduce spillage, splattering and the possibility of injury from scalding. Slowly build up to the required speed setting.

The max. size of the container used for mixing ingredients should not exceed 2 I.

CAUTION: Switch off the hand mixer before adding or removing food from the mixing jug or bowl.

Attachments

The mixing beater attachments are ideal for mixing light ingredients such as egg whites, cream and instant desserts. To avoid spillage, it is best to start slowly and build up to the required speed one setting at a time.

The dough hook attachments are ideal for mixing bread dough. For best results, make sure that the dough is not too dry and use the dough hooks on a lower speed setting.

Turbo Button

Above the 5-speed selector switch there is a turbo button. This will activate the highest speed setting as long as it is pressed, and can be used to a burst of higher mixing speed while using a different speed setting.

NOTE: The hand mixer must be switched on for the turbo button to be used. If the switch is set to '0', the turbo button will not activate.

Storage

Check that the hand mixer is cool, clean and dry before storing in a cool, dry place.

Never wrap the cord tightly around the hand mixer; wrap it loosely to avoid causing damage.
