Please read all of the instructions carefully and retain for future reference.

Safety Instructions

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed.

Check that the voltage indicated on the rating plate corresponds with that of the local network before connecting the appliance to the mains power supply.

Children aged from 8 years and people with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge can use this appliance, only if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

Unless they are older than 8 and supervised, children should not perform cleaning or user maintenance.

This appliance is not a toy.

This appliance contains no user serviceable parts. If the power supply cord, plug or any part of the appliance is malfunctioning, or if the appliance has been dropped or damaged, only a qualified electrician should carry out repairs. Improper repairs may place the user at risk of harm. Keep the appliance and its power supply cord out of the

Reep the appliance and its power supply cord out of the reach of children.

Keep the appliance and its power supply cord away from heat or sharp edges that could cause damage.

Keep the appliance away from heat emitting appliances.

Keep hands, fingers, hair and any loose clothing away from the rotating tools of the appliance.

Do not touch any moving parts on this appliance during use, as this could cause injury.

Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.

Do not operate the appliance with wet hands.

Do not use broken or loose cutting or rotating blades.

Do not overload the appliance as the mixture level may rise during blending.

Do not leave the appliance unattended whilst connected to the mains power supply.

Do not remove the appliance from the mains power supply by pulling the cord; switch it off and remove the plug by hand. Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.

Do not use any accessories other than those supplied.

Do not use this appliance outdoors.

Do not store the appliance in direct sunlight or in high humidity conditions.

Do not move the appliance whilst it is in use.

Do not place boiling water or very hot liquid in the appliance.

Always unplug the appliance after use and before any cleaning or user maintenance.

Always use the appliance on a stable, heat-resistant surface, at a height that is comfortable for the user.

Use of an extension cord with the appliance is not recommended.

This appliance should not be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote control system, other than that supplied with this appliance.

This appliance is intended for domestic use only. It should not be used for commercial purposes.

Warning: Do not touch sharp blades.

Thermal Cut-out Device

The NutriPulse is fitted with a thermal safety cut-out device, built in to prevent it from overheating. Should the NutriPulse start to overheat, the thermal safety cut-out system will automatically operate and switch it off.

If this happens, switch off and unplug the NutriPulse from the mains power supply and allow it to fully cool for approx. 15 minutes.

Check the cross-blade lid attachment for anything that could be causing a blockage.

Plug in and switch on the NutriPulse at the mains power supply.

Caution: In order to avoid a hazard due to inadvertent resetting of the thermal cut-out, the NutriPulse must not be supplied through an external switching device, such as a timer, or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off by the utility.

Care and Maintenance

Switch off and unplug the NutriPulse from the mains power supply before performing any cleaning or user maintenance. Wipe the NutriPulse base unit with a soft, damp cloth and allow to dry thoroughly.

Wash all of the accessories, except the cross-blade lid attachment in warm, soapy water, then rinse and dry thoroughly. Never touch the blades; using extreme caution, clean the blades with a brush and dry carefully.

Never immerse the NutriPulse base unit in water or any other liquid.

Do not use harsh or abrasive scourers to clean the NutriPulse, as this could cause damage.

The NutriPulse is not suitable for use in a dishwasher. Always clean the blender immediately after each use. **Warning:** Handle the cross-blade lid attachment with care, as the blades are sharp. Exercise caution when attaching, removing, cleaning or storing the attachments.

Getting Started

Remove the appliance from the box. Remove any packaging from the appliance.

Place the packaging inside the box and either store or dispose of safely.

Introduction

The NutriPulse is versatile and compact, making it perfect for those on the go. It makes light work of crushing ice, chopping and blending as well as nutrient and vitamin extraction. The lightweight design is sleek and shatter-resistant, with easy-to-carry cups ideal for an active lifestyle.

Instructions for Use

Before First Use

Before using the NutriPulse for the first time, wash all of the accessories in warm, soapy water, then rinse and dry thoroughly.

Wipe the NutriPulse base unit with a soft, damp cloth and allow to dry thoroughly. Do not immerse the NutriPulse base unit in water or any other liquid.

Note: When using the NutriPulse for the first time, a slight odour may be emitted. This is normal and will soon subside. Allow for sufficient ventilation around the NutriPulse.

Using the NutriPulse 700 W

STEP 1: Position the NutriPulse base unit onto a flat, stable surface, at a height that is comfortable for the user.

STEP 2: Place the ingredients into the blending cup, making sure that they are no larger than 3 cm in size and that they do not exceed the max. fill mark.

STEP 3: Pour a small amount of chosen liquid into the blending cup; this will help to blend the ingredients.

STEP 4: Secure the cross-blade lid attachment onto the blending cup by twisting it in a clockwise direction.

STEP 5: Plug in and switch on the NutriPulse at the mains power supply.

STEP 6: Invert the blending cup so that the cross-blade lid attachment is facing downwards. Align the three tabs in the cross blade lid attachment with the corresponding slots on the NutriPulse base unit and then gently push it down. Twist the blending cup clockwise to lock it into position.

STEP 7: For a continuous blend, press and hold the power button. To stop blending, release the power button. To pulse blend the ingredients, repeatedly press and release the power button until the desired consistency is reached.

STEP 8: When the ingredients are sufficiently blended, switch off and unplug the NutriPulse from the mains power supply.

STEP 9: Gently twist the blending cup in an anticlockwise direction and lift away from the NutriPulse base unit.

STEP 10: Invert the blending cup and remove the cross-blade lid attachment by twisting it in an anticlockwise direction. Replace it with an easy-drink lid if required.

Note: Check that the lid is securely fitted before use. If the blades are not running smoothly, stop the NutriPulse and carefully remove the cross-blade lid attachment. Add a small amount of cold liquid or reduce the quantity of the ingredients in the blending cup.

When mixing liquid, use a tall container or blend small quantities at a time to reduce spillage, splattering and the possibility of injury from scalding.

Caution: Take care when handling the cross-blade lid attachment, as the blades may get hot during use.

Warning: Do not blend warm or hot liquid or food, as this may cause a pressure build-up and serious injury. Do not blend for long periods of time. Max. operation time is 45 seconds; allow the NutriPulse to cool for 1 minute before using it again. Using the NutriPulse for longer than 45 seconds at a time will cause the temperature to increase, which may in turn lead to a pressure build-up. If this happens, switch off and unplug the NutriPulse from the mains power supply and allow it to cool thoroughly before attempting to remove the cross-blade lid attachment.

Warning: Do not immerse the blending cup in cold water at this time.

Do not exceed the max. fill mark when adding ingredients to the blending cup, as this could cause spillage and may damage the NutriPulse.

Do not operate the NutriPulse if the blending cup is cracked, broken or empty.

Handy Hint

If the ingredients do not blend evenly, remove the blending cup from the NutriPulse base unit. Shake the blending cup to redistribute the ingredients and then blend once more.

Storage

Reassemble the NutriPulse.

Check that the NutriPulse is cool, clean and dry before storing in a cool, dry place.

The drink still contains lumps.	There are too many ingredients in the blending cup.	Reduce the amount of ingredients in the blending cup.
The drink is watery and lacking flavour.	The ingredients have been overblended.	Use the NutriPulse to pulse blend ingredients in short bursts for the best results.

Method

Chop any large ingredients into small pieces no larger than 3 cm, to help with the blending process.

Place all of the ingredients into the large blending cup and then add the cross-blade lid attachment.

Invert the blending cup and place it onto the NutriPulse base unit.

Blend until the drink reaches the desired consistency.

Remove the blending cup from the NutriPulse base unit and then detach the cross-blade lid attachment


Attach the easy-drink lid to enjoy straight from the blending cup.

The wire coloured **BLUE** is the **NEUTRAL** and must be connected to the terminal marked **N** or coloured **BLACK**.

The wire coloured **BROWN** is the **LIVE** wire and must be connected to the terminal marked **L** or coloured **RED**.



Always ensure that the cord grip is fastened correctly.


The plug must be fitted with a fuse of the same rating already fitted and conforming to BS 1362 and be ASTA approved.
