Battery Safety

This product is supplied with 2 x AA batteries. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as those recommended should be used with this product. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.

Exhausted batteries should be removed from the product to avoid leakage.

If the display begins to disappear or the alarm sounds faint, replace the batteries.

Care and Maintenance

Wipe the exterior of the timer with a soft, damp cloth and allow it to dry thoroughly.

Never immerse the timer in water or any other liquid.

Do not use harsh or abrasive cleaning detergents or scourers to clean the timer, as this could cause damage.

Before First Use

Remove the plastic isolator tab from the battery compartment (if present) prior to use.

Make sure the batteries are inserted following the correct polarity.

Modes

timer Timer mode: For regular count up or down timing.

'Turn 20' reminder mode: A reminder to turn over food whilst cooking on high heat; helps to achieve evenly cooked food and juicier results.

Temperature reminder mode: Sounds an alarm 85 % of the way through cooking times to remind users to check the temperature of the food.

Using the Timer Mode

STEP 1: Press MODE until **timer** is displayed. STEP 2: Press H located on the left edge of the timer to set the hours and press M located on the right edge of the timer to set the minutes.

STEP 3: Press ►II to start the timer.

STEP 4: Press ►11 again to pause, resume or silence the alarm.

Using the Count Up Timer

Make sure the display shows **00:00:00**, then press ►**II** to start timing.

Using Turn 20 Reminder Mode

STEP 1: Press **MODE** until **TURN 20** is displayed. **STEP 2:** Once the food begins cooking, press ►II to start the timer.

STEP 3: Rotate the food each time the alarm sounds or until the desired level of doneness is reached.

Using the Temperature Reminder Mode

STEP 1: Press MODE until TEMPERATURE

REMINDER is displayed.

STEP 2: Press \mathbf{H} to set the hours and \mathbf{M} to set the minutes.

STEP 3: Press ▶II to start the timer once cooking has begun. An alarm will sound 85 % of the way through cooking times to remind users to check the temperature of the food.

STEP 4: Press > 11 to silence the alarm and allow the timer to run for the remainder of the cooking time.

Resetting to Zero

Press >II and MODE together to reset the display to 00:00:00.
